

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next seven years to 710 tCO $_2$ e by 2030. This is a reduction of 50%. We will then look to half emissions again by 2040 with the goal of achieving Net Zero by 2050.

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2022 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to tbc tCO₂e, a tbc%ge reduction against the 2022 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract

This is the first year following the baseline year but we have moved offices to a more energy efficient property and we are reviewing our suppliers' carbon emissions. In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

Gain ISO14001 accreditation
Gain Green Mark accreditation
Review offsetting carbon/ tree planting schemes for that which we cannot reduce
